### **General Transfer Guidelines for DSST Exam Scores:**

- 1) All **Minimum Passing Scores** listed on this guide are based on ACE Recommend Scores.
- 2) **Awarded Semester Hours** are based on whether or not students have met minimum passing score on DSST exam and are subject to transcript evaluation.
- 3) No scores below the **Minimum Passing Scores** will be accepted.
- 4) Remedial/pre-college level courses, audit, credit, proficiency scores are not transferrable.
- 5) **Important Note Course and DSST Exam Scores Expiration Dates: # Science and Math course work and DSST Exams Scores** for the **BSIT (Radiology) program** must have been completed no more than five years prior to the intended start date.
- 6) **†Science coursework and DSST Exam Scores for the BSN-Pre-licensure program** must have been completed no more than seven years prior to the intended start date. For example, a student entering the program in the **2017** must have completed the required computer courses during the **2010** semester or later. †
