Transfer Guidelines:

- 1) Grades of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale completed at regionally accredited colleges or universities are transferrable.
- 2) Remedial/pre-college level courses, audit, credit, proficiency scores are not transferrable.
- 3) No courses with final grades below 2.0 on a 4.0 scale may be transferred.
- 4) Curriculum GPA must be 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- 5) **Important Note Course Expiration Dates: Science and computer coursework for the BSN-Pre-licensure program** must have been completed no more than five years prior to the intended start date. For example, a student entering the program in the fall of 2015 must have completed the required computer courses during the fall of 2010 semester or later. †
